Outside Your Home

Most water use—and water waste—occurs outside the home. The following products can help maximize landscape water efficiency:

- 4 Mulch Adding 2-3 inches of organic mulch reduces evaporation and can save 20-30 gallons each time you water (per 1,000 square feet)
- 5 Automatic shut-off nozzle for hoses
 This simple tool can save 8–18 gallons of water per minute
- 6 Low water-use plants and trees Installing low water-use plants can save 30–60 gallons each time you water (per 1,000 square feet)
- 7 Rotary sprinkler nozzles High-efficiency sprinkler heads help reduce water waste by limiting irrigation run-off
- 8 Drip and inline irrigation kits Starter kits make it easy to install a water-efficient drip irrigation system
- 9 Automatic hose timer Hose timers can automatically turn drip or hose-end sprinklers on or off
- Rain sensor Rain sensors save water and money by stopping the irrigation system from watering in the rain
