

Arden-Cordova Water Supply Update

- Golden State Water currently has an adequate water supply to meet the needs of our customers.
 However, we always encourage efficient water use, especially at a time when water resources are
 limited in several regions throughout our state. It is important to remember that water is a finite
 resource that should be used wisely.
- Although no water restrictions are currently in place for Arden-Cordova, we are encouraging
 customers to voluntarily reduce their water use by 20 percent. This situation could change
 depending on continued dry weather conditions.
- Customers are encouraged to engage in water-efficient practices, including immediately repairing leaks and preventing water runoff from irrigation. Our technicians are monitoring wasteful water practices throughout our service area to help support the community in reducing water usage.

Water-Use Efficiency Tips

Inside the Home

- Survey your property to identify and repair leaks in faucets, pipes and toilets.
- Maximize water efficiency by using shorter cycles and only washing full loads of laundry and dishes.
- Keep a pitcher of water in your refrigerator, instead of running the tap for a cold glass of water.

Outside the Home

- Eliminate wasteful water runoffs in gutters and storm drains.
- Install a smart irrigation controller that automatically manages watering based on weather conditions.
- Plant landscaping that is native to the climate and requires less water.
- Use a bucket of water to wash your car, rather than running the hose.
- Use a broom instead of a hose to clean driveways, sidewalks and patios.
