Student Videos Showcase Creativity, Humor

Water Spots Videos Need Your Vote!

SACRAMENTO—Humor, animation and even an original jingle or two—these are some of the highlights from the more than 70 videos submitted as part of the 2015 Water Spots Video Contest.



Sponsored by the Regional Water Authority (RWA), *Sacramento Bee* and local water providers, the contest challenged teens to create videos focused on the 2015 theme "BEAT THE LEAK: Find and fix leaks fast" for a chance to win cash prizes.

A panel of distinguished judges narrowed the videos down to 10 finalists, **now it's the public's** turn to vote for their favorite by Sunday, March 29, 2015 at www.sacbee.com/mie.

Leaks can waste 10,000 gallons per year (the equivalent of 270 loads of laundry) for an average household. Videos conveyed thoughtful and clever messages about finding and fixing leaks fast. Several demonstrated how leaks can quickly add up to thousands of wasted gallons. Another urged viewers to become a "household hero" by fixing leaky faucets today.
