Learn to Create a Beautiful, Water-Wise Landscape

SACRAMENTO—Fall is upon us, and it's the perfect time of the year to #RethinkYourYard and to create a beautiful, water-wise landscape at your home.

Sacramento Suburban Water District (SSWD) and EcoLandscape California are hosting a special workshop series beginning September 20, 2016 to provide the knowledge and tools needed to get started.

The five-session River-Friendly, Green Gardening series, taught by the sustainable landscaping experts at EcoLandscape California, includes three classroom workshops and two hands-on training days that will cover:

- Landscape design
- Putting the right plant in the right place
- Water-wise irrigation
- Integrated pest management
- How to care for your landscape
- And much, much more



Classroom workshops will take place at SSWD's Antelope Gardens at 7800 Antelope North Road in Antelope as follows:

- Tuesday, September 20, 2016 from 6:30 to 8:30 p.m.
- Tuesday, September 27, 2016 from 6:30 to 8:30 p.m.
- Tuesday, October 4, 2016 from 6:30 to 8:30 p.m.

Attendees can then practice what they've learned at two special hands-on workshops on Saturdays, September 24, 2016 and October 15, 2016 from 9:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. at a landscape installation in the Arden area of Carmichael (exact location to be announced to participants). Lunch will be provided.
